### Malignant prostate cancer

#### **Niraparib / abiraterone acetate**

Niraparib / abiraterone acetate is indicated with prednisone or prednisolone: - in combination with androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) for the treatment of adult patients with metastatic hormone-sensitive prostate cancer (mHSPC) and BRCA 1/2 mutations (germline and/or somatic). - for the treatment of adult patients with metastatic castration-resistant prostate cancer (mCRPC) and BRCA 1/2 mutations (germline and/or somatic) in whom chemotherapy is not clinically indicated.
