## Tracheal, bronchus, and lung cancer

### Cemiplimab

Cemiplimab as monotherapy is indicated for the first-line treatment of adult patients with non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) expressing PD-L1 (in  $\geq 50\%$  tumour cells), with no EGFR, ALK or ROS1 aberrations, who have:

- locally advanced NSCLC who are not candidates for definitive chemoradiation, or
- metastatic NSCLC.
